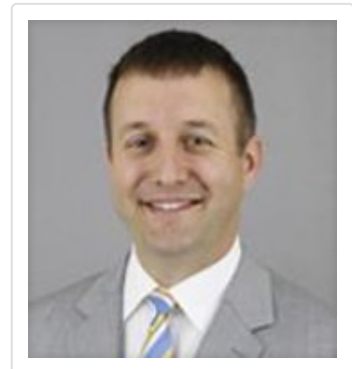

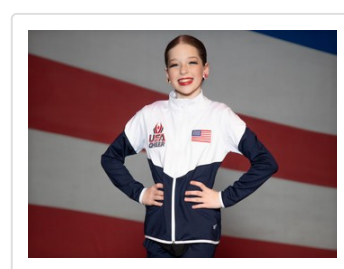
## Dolphins Celebrate 60th Year; Perform Next Week
