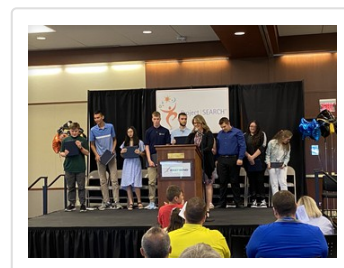
### Give CTE Standards Feedback
