Homecoming Week at West Bend School District Begins on October 7 Athletic Hall of Fame Induction is on October 11 at Football Game

- The Homecoming Parade will begin at 4:15 p.m. at Decorah Rd. and Lincoln Dr. in West Bend and move east on Decorah Rd., ending in the west parking lot of the high schools building.
- The West Bend High Schools Athletic Hall of Fame induction ceremony will take place at 6:40 p.m. in the football stadium at 1305 E. Decorah Road, West Bend. Inductees include:

- The varsity football game between West and East will begin at 7 p.m. at the football stadium. West High School is the home team.
- Fireworks will be set off near the stadium just after the football game is complete.

Other East vs West high school athletic events during the week include:

- Tuesday, October 8: The East vs West JV volleyball games begin at 5:15 p.m. and the varsity game at 7 p.m. in the high schools fieldhouse at 1305 E. Decorah Road, West Bend.
- Tuesday, October 8: The East vs West boys soccer game will begin at 7 p.m. on the high schools soccer field, at the southeast corner of E. Decorah Road and River Road.
- Thursday, October 10: The West vs East JV2 football game is at 4:30 p.m. at the football stadium.

All schools will have dress-up days, with the East and West theme for the week being "Happiest Place on Earth." Finally, the Homecoming dance, open to high school students only, is Saturday, October 12 at the high schools fieldhouse.
