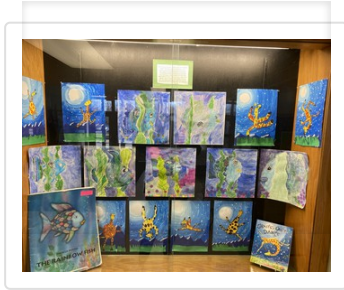
Early Learning Program Enrollment

Families can begin enrolling students in the 4K program for 2023-2024 on January 30. On the same day, Head Start enrollment also opens. The West Bend School District is the Washington County provider of Head Start and offers classes at the Rolfs Education Center (near Badger Middle School), Jackson Area Community Center, and Kettle Moraine YMCA on West Washington.



Enrollment is completed online in Skyward and information can be entered early and submitted on the 30th. Go to the [Early Learning Programs website](#) for details.

Students enrolled in the 4K program THIS school year are automatically enrolled for kindergarten for 2023-2024. If a student is not enrolled in the WBSD's 4K, they may be enrolled for kindergarten beginning January 30. [Enrollment is completed online](#). 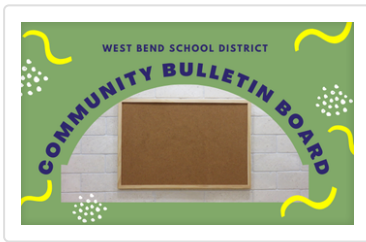
