A Message from Jen Wimmer

Families,

You and your family members can assist in making our schools, district, and community a positive environment for all students. I ask that you please talk to your child(ren) about the importance of never using derogatory terms towards other people under any circumstances. Students in the West Bend School District learn the pillars of the WBSD Way, of which one is Be Respectful.

Behaviors of Concern

As I engage with regional leaders as well as our own principals, we discuss issues facing students we serve and behaviors of concern as they emerge. We want to reinforce our district expectation that no one should be using biased, hurtful, or offensive language. Whether spoken, written, sung as part of a song, said directly to someone or overheard—words cause harm. Racial comments and/or other forms of hate speech will not be condoned. Students will face disciplinary action if they are found to have used this type of language.

Behaviors of concern also include students' perception that they have been given permission to repeat racial slurs in certain circumstances or with specific friends. Please remind your child(ren) that they cannot give or receive permission from other students to use hurtful language. Additionally, there are reports of students engaging in behavior outside of school that encourages the use of unacceptable language, photos, etc. while others video record and then share with a wider audience. In these cases students who receive and share inappropriate videos, chats, etc. may also receive consequences.

Reporting

Students and families are encouraged to report incidents directly to a school administrator for investigation and follow-up. We also have [two additional tip lines](#) to support students and families when they "see something, say something." Behavior reports are further monitored by our Student Services Department administrators. If you have already contacted the school

Student and Family Education

To further support student and family understanding, we will be planning to reinforce digital citizenship lessons and information for students and will schedule guest speakers for families to help grow understanding of various aspects of social media. As we plan these opportunities, we will keep you informed.

With this message, I want to ensure that families are made aware of developing concerns and our commitment to swift action when investigating and handling inappropriate behavior. There is no place for this type of language or other harassing language or behavior in the West Bend School District and it will not be tolerated. We greatly appreciate your partnership and our partnership with both the Jackson Police Department and the West Bend Police Department and our School Liaison Officers. Behaviors and/or language that threatens or creates an unsafe environment will result in law enforcement involvement. Feel free to reach out to your school administrator(s), Director of Student Services, or me with any questions or concerns.

Additional Information on Reporting

There are two additional reporting services used by the West Bend School District. Please review the details of each below.



SpeakUP for Safety (West Bend School District)

West Bend School District students or their family members can use this service to report items of concern to the school district. Feel free to report any threats, concerns about student safety or well-being, or a safety issue in the schools, buses, or events via email (speakup@wbsd-schools.org) or text/call (262-357-3530). With SpeakUP for Safety, when a student reports a tip the monitoring company will evaluate the report 24/7 and 365 days a year. It will send an email to WBSD administrators for non life-threatening reports. If there is an emergency situation it will call local law enforcement or WBSD administrators.

Speak Up, Speak Out (State of Wisconsin)

With Speak Up, Speak Out Wisconsin, when a person needs help, anyone can report a tip via the Speak Up Speak Out app or by calling 1-800-MY-SUSO-1 (1-800-697-8761) to get a live dispatcher. (No text messages are accepted.) It is a way to get important information directly to law enforcement, such as threat reporting, threat assessment consultation, critical incident response, and general school safety guidance.


