Civics Team Wins State Championship

A team of students from East and West High Schools won the third annual Wisconsin Civics Games, presented by the Wisconsin Newspaper Association Foundation. The winning team was made up of Owen Damkot (West jr.), Danny Zolp (East jr.), Abby Lockrem (West sr.), and Myah Latour (West jr.) and were advised by social studies teacher Mark Drake. Each member of the team won a \$2,000 scholarship to a Wisconsin college or university of their choice. Another team from East and West competed at the event, which featured 13 schools from across the state that had advanced from a field of 166 during regional contests.

P.S. There is also a fishing club at East and West High Schools that has participated in competitions.



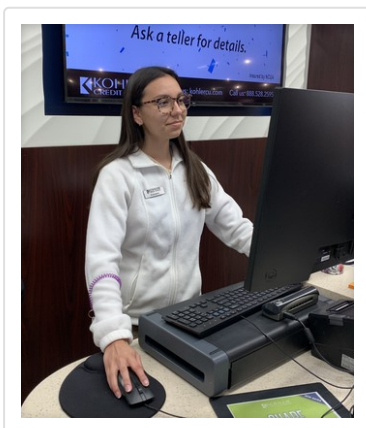
Tribute Video for Memorial Day

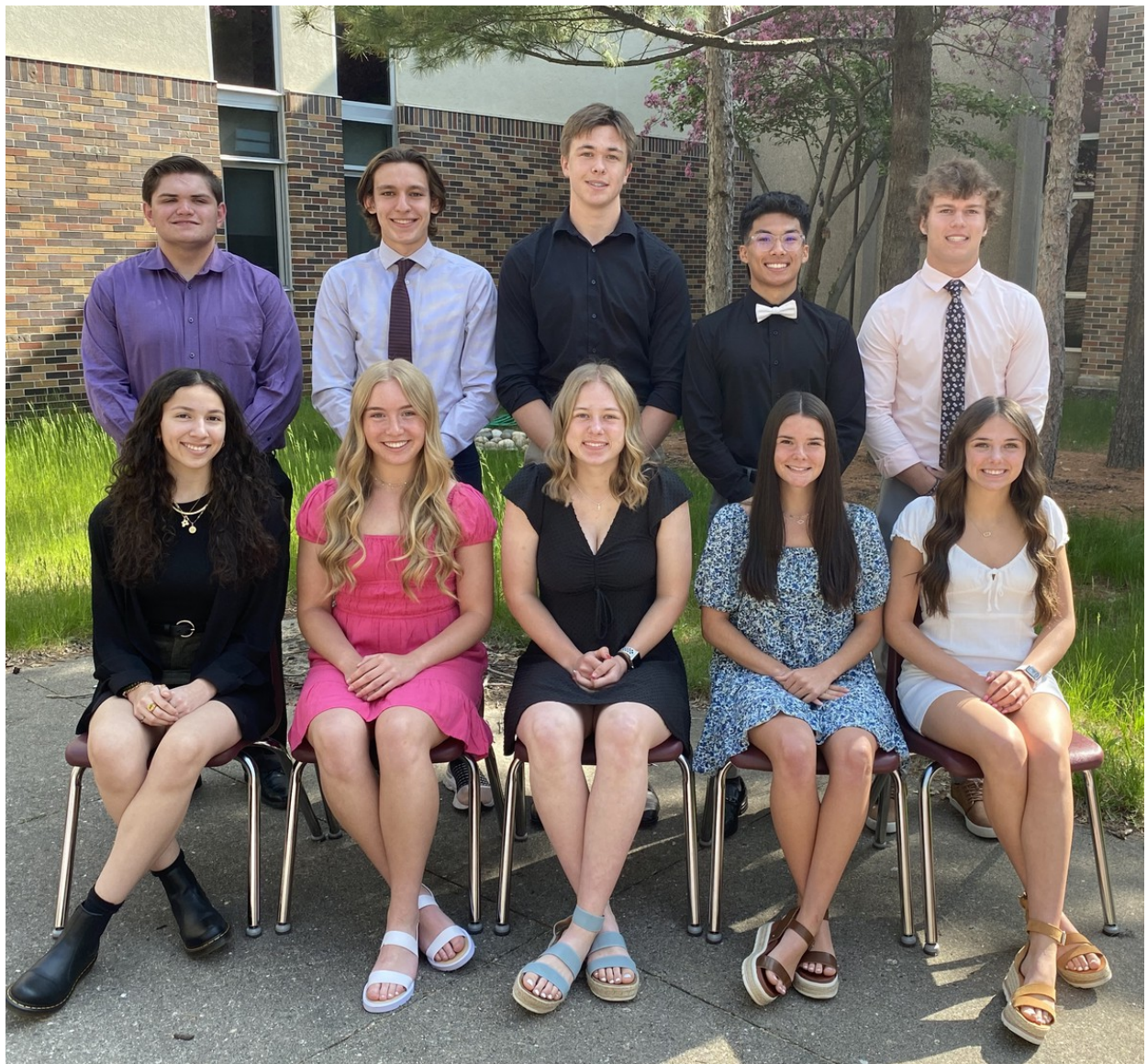
