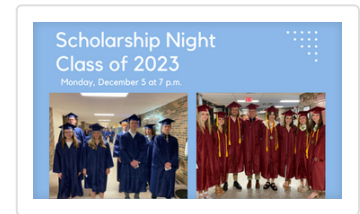
Support Scholarships with Milwaukee Symphony Orchestra
