Life-Saving Efforts at Football Game

At the West Bend School Board meeting on Monday, October 10, the board recognized several people for their role in providing life-saving medical assistance through CPR and defibrillator administration at the September 23 West Bend East football game.

Tom Wenzlaff was leaving the press box when he required immediate medical assistance for a cardiac event. West Bend Police Officer Adam Doleschy, WBHS Trainer Kyle Butters, and WBHS School Nurse Jen Schepp rendered immediate aid. Thankfully, Tom has recovered. West Bend Fire Department paramedics continued CPR, provided Advanced Cardiac Life Support medications, and additional defibrillator administration. They then transported Tom to Froedtert Hospital in Wauwatosa. The West Bend Fire Department says, "His survival is a testament to the necessity for bystander CPR and Advanced Life Support measures by paramedics to have good patient outcomes." 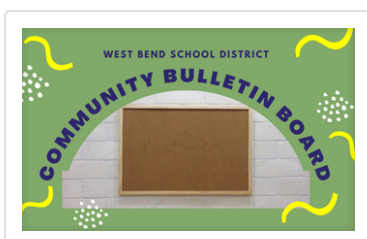
Textbook Review until Oct. 19
