Playoffs Ticketing Information

This week the West Bend East volleyball and football teams will host the following playoff contests:

Volleyball: Thursday, October 20 at 7 p.m. at the West Bend High Schools Fieldhouse

Football: Friday, October 21 at 7 p.m. at the West Bend High Schools Carl Pick Stadium

Details on ticketing for both events:

- Advanced purchase, credit/debit card, and Apple Pay payments ONLY
- No cash for tickets will be accepted
- No passes are accepted for WIAA playoffs
- All adults, seniors, students, and children must purchase a ticket for WIAA playoffs
- Tickets are \$7.30 for adults and \$2.05 for children age 5 and under

Bring your mobile device and show gate personnel, who will validate your ticket for admission.

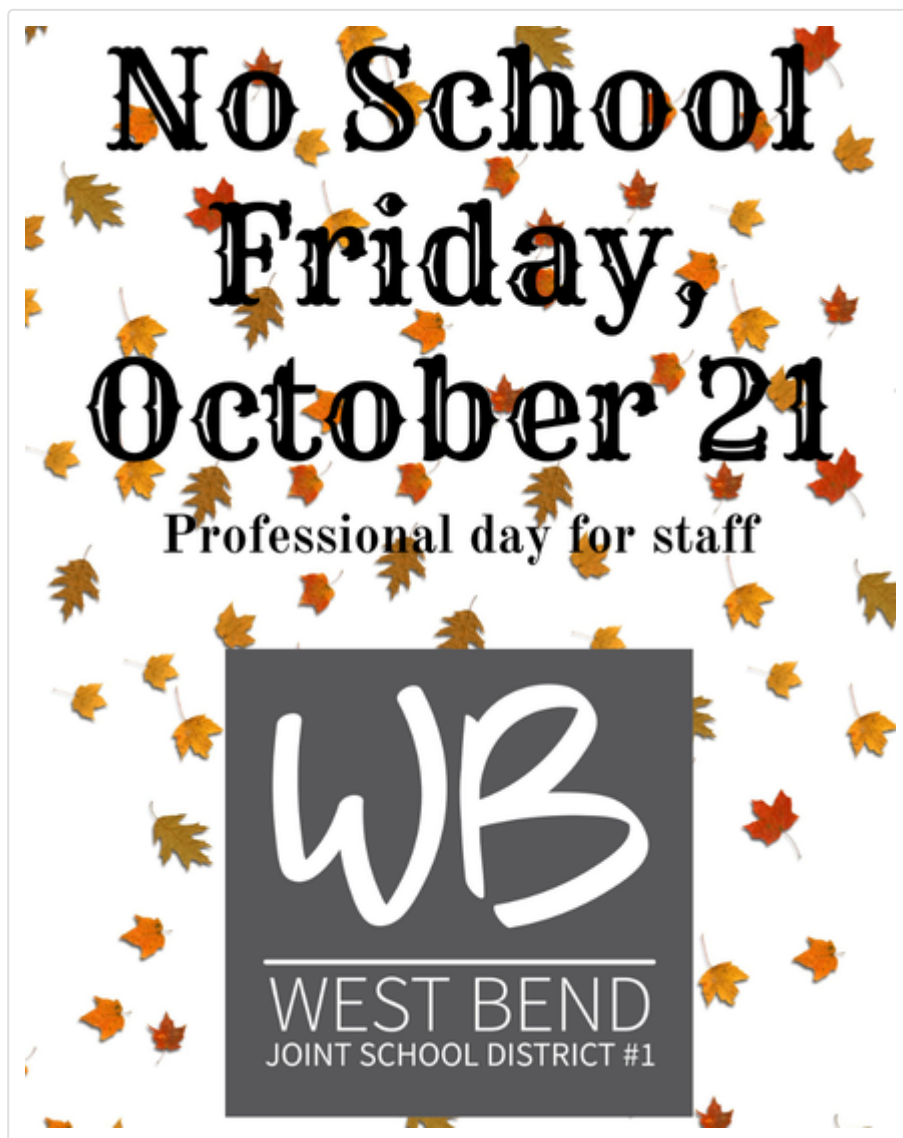
Testing Site Remains Open

The free COVID-19 testing site for West Bend School District students and staff is located at the former Jackson Fire Department building on Jackson Drive. There are some operational changes per guidelines from the State of Wisconsin:

- Testing is available for staff and students of the district. This is a change from last year when household members of staff and students were also able to get tested at the testing site.

- The hours are Monday - Friday 6:30 - 9:30 a.m. We have selected these hours to ensure staff and students have the ability to get tested prior to the start of the school day.
- The testing site will primarily do rapid antigen testing only. The testing site will be able to use PCR testing if it is needed to confirm the results of a rapid antigen test. This means you may need to wait at the testing site for your rapid test results to then determine if a PCR is needed.
