Approval of 2022-2023 Budget

During its meeting on October 24, the West Bend School Board approved the 2022-2023 West Bend School District budget and property tax levy. The budget includes a mill rate of \$6.37, which is a \$1.60 reduction from the previous mill rate of \$7.97 that was in place for four years. [Review details of the property tax levy and more.](#)

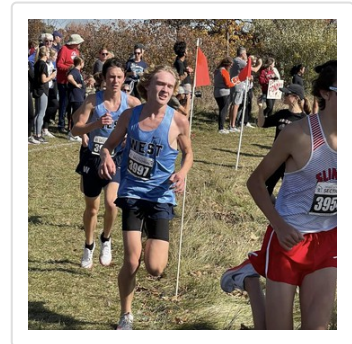

Academic Accolades for Golfers

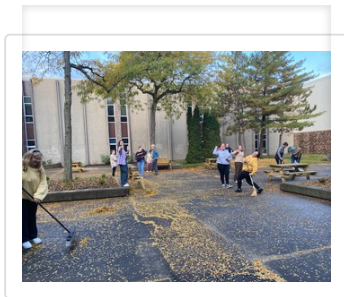

Library Contest

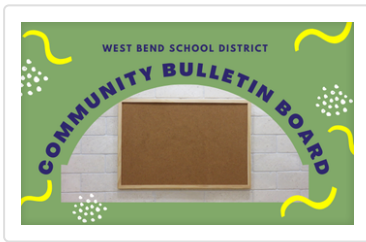
The McLane library is holding a contest every week in October. This student guessed the emoji story title correctly and won a prize.
