West Bend School District 4K Enrollment Begins January 27 Nature-Based 4K Program to be Held at WBSD Outdoor Science Education Center

West Bend — Enrollment for the West Bend School District's 4K program for the 2025-2026 school year begins on Monday, January 27, 2025. Children are eligible for 4K if they turn 4 years old by September 1, 2025. Enrollment is completed at WBSD4K.org.

The 4K program is available at no cost for families residing within the West Bend School District attendance area. Families living outside the district are welcome to apply through the Parental Choice (open enrollment) program to access the program.

In September 2025, the West Bend School District will operate one of its two nature-based 4K programs at its Outdoor Science Education Center. This 40-acre site, located across the street from the high schools building near the southeast corner of River and Decorah Roads, includes a heated building, nature trails, and ponds. Currently, the program is using the Riveredge Nature Center in Newburg.

Operated through a partnership between the Kettle Moraine YMCA and the West Bend School District, the nature-based 4K program features students spending two days a week at Holy Trinity in Newburg and two days (4K is in session Monday-Thursday) at the WBSD Outdoor Science Education Center. The other nature-based 4K program is also operated as a partnership with the YMCA and is located at Trinity Lutheran and Camp Silver Brook in West Bend.

In total, the school district partners with three community-based preschool partners to provide 4K in seven locations:

The West Bend School District's 4K program features a play-based learning model that fosters children's natural curiosity through hands-on activities designed to promote exploration, problem-solving, and meaningful engagement.

In addition, all locations incorporate nature-inspired learning, with two sites offering nature-based programming where students spend half of their time outdoors participating in structured lessons that encourage curiosity and discovery.

To support busy families, most sites provide wraparound daycare options, allowing children to remain at their assigned location if additional care is needed.
