West Bend — Four students of the West Bend School District were selected for the Wisconsin School Music Association Middle Level State Honors Music Project choir. Students in grades 6-8 are eligible for the middle level honors choir.

Chloe Bauer, Shay Feiter, and Bryce Sumner of Badger Middle School and Kyla Kuzminski of Silverbrook Intermediate school were selected for the choir after auditions earlier this year. There were among nearly 700 students who auditioned for the 250 available positions in the middle level honors state music project.

These four students and other musically accomplished youth will attend rehearsals, activities, and events and then perform with nationally-known conductors in a professional setting on October 29 and 30, 2021.
