The West Bend School District will provide for student health care services in accordance with state law and established procedures. The objective of nursing services is to assist in creating an educational environment that is safe and addresses the physical care and concern for students while they are at school or are participating in school activities.

In the event of emergency situations, District staff shall respond by calling 9-1-1.

Nursing services will be provided under the direction of a registered nurse currently licensed to practice professional nursing in Wisconsin. The school nurse will adhere to standards of professional practice including standards related to conduct, confidentiality, delegation and documentation as governed in the Wisconsin Nurse Practice Act.

Each school year, parent/guardian shall be required to complete/review the West Bend School District Emergency information to be kept on file for each student in the building they attend.

In accordance with state laws and rules, the superintendent/designee and Board of Education shall annually review the emergency nursing services program.
