Naming of school district facilities is the responsibility of the Board of Education and shall be by majority vote of the entire Board. In any particular case and/or cases the board may delegate approval authority to the Superintendent. The criteria for naming school facilities, parts of facilities, or additions to facilities will be established by the School Board on a case to case basis. Criteria that may be considered when naming school facilities would include but are not limited to:

1. The granting of Naming Rights must always be consistent with the District vision and mission.
2. The Department/School affected by the naming right to be granted must be consulted before any decision is made.
3. The District shall not grant a Naming Right without the informed consent of the named party or the named party's legal representative.
4. Monetary valuations may be assigned to Naming Rights possibilities on a case to case basis to aid with making decisions about granting Naming Rights.

All Naming Rights criteria must be established by the board/designee prior to any formal funding/donations and/or plans for renovations.
