The School Board and District are committed to cultivating and maintaining positive relationships with our students, families, staff, and the communities they serve. The School Board encourages partnerships with education organizations (i.e. Educational Foundations, Parent Teacher Organizations, etc.), local and state government, as well as community organizations including businesses, private or parochial schools, etc. The District works to create communication that showcases student learning and provides information of interest to citizens regarding the organization. The district website and social media accounts are used to share communication with the public.

To ensure the safety and wellbeing of students and staff, the School Board recognizes the need for, and is supportive of first responders, emergency personnel, and law enforcement presence in our schools. The School Board encourages close cooperation with law enforcement agencies, both through resource programs and through the presence of the police liaison officer(s) in the schools. The School Board recognizes that the responsibility to cooperate with law enforcement agencies must be balanced with the District's duty to maintain an appropriate learning environment.

The School Board appreciates organizations that would like to partner in its efforts to support our students and our schools. Should an organization desire to partner with and use the name of the district or its schools, they must first obtain the approval of the Superintendent or his/her designee as a prerequisite to organizing.
